A TALE OF TWO SYNODS

Crown of Life welcomes Dr. Mark Braun, professor emeritus of theology from Wisconsin Lutheran College, as our guest presenter for the Sunday Bible class for four weeks starting January 22. Dr. Braun's class is called *A Tale of Two Synods*, and examines the history of the former relationship between our church body, the WELS (Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod), and LCMS (Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod), especially the events that eventually led to the break in fellowship between these two church bodies in 1961. That history still affects our churches today. Dr. Braun has done extensive research in this area and has also written a book that documents this history, which class members will have an opportunity to purchase. Please join us for this fascinating study in the Timothy Room on Sundays starting at 9:25 a.m. from January 22 to February 12.
