A TALE OF TWO SYNODS: CLASS & BOOK

Our current Sunday morning study, A Tale of Two Synods with Dr. Mark Braun, is underway and continues through February 12. JESUS' PASSION: UNANSWERED QUESTIONS

Every year we hear the story of Jesus' Passion—his sufferings and death that redeemed the world from sin—but there are still many facets of the story we've never discussed or had the opportunity to ask questions about. Our Sunday Bible study from February 19 to April 2 will give you the chance to dig into the Passion history in ways you never have before. During the first session (February 19), class participants will help to determine the specific questions we will consider each week thereafter. Ask the questions you've always wondered about but never have had answered! Join us as we take a unique look at Jesus' Passion, recorded in Matthew 26-27. Pastor Johnold Strey leads this study on Sunday mornings between services from 9:25 to 10:15 a.m. in the Timothy Room.

MIDWEEK WORSHIP FOR LENT

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22. Crown of Life adds additional services during Lent on Wednesdays at 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. Our midweek services during Lent run from February 22 to March 29. (During Lent, our usual Thursday evening services are postponed, and resume after Easter Sunday.) On Ash Wednesday, worship focuses on confession and absolution and includes the imposition of ashes and the Lord's Supper. The remaining five services take us through the Passion History of Jesus, this year using Matthew's Gospel as our guide. We will also hear a sermon series called, "His Final Steps," preached by the pastors and vicars from our congregation and from St. Paul Lutheran Church in Slinger. Dinner will be served between services each week in the Timothy Room. Please join us as we make our annual journey to the Savior's cross!
