MIDWEEK WORSHIP FOR LENT

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22. Crown of Life adds additional services during Lent on Wednesdays at 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. Our midweek services during Lent run from February 22 to March 29. (During Lent, our usual Thursday evening services are postponed, and resume after Easter Sunday.) On Ash Wednesday, worship focuses on confession and absolution and includes the imposition of ashes and the Lord's Supper. The remaining five services take us through the Passion History of Jesus, this year using Matthew's Gospel as our guide. We will also hear a sermon series called, "His Final Steps," preached by the pastors and vicars from our congregation and from St. Paul Lutheran Church in Slinger.
