### DAVID: A MAN AFTER THE LORD'S HEART

This is the second week in our four-part Sunday Bible study led by Vicar Samuel Helwig called "David: A Man after the Lord's Heart." We are studying sections of the Old Testament that describe the reign of King David, an important ancestor of Jesus Christ. When God rejected Saul, the king before David, the prophet Samuel said about David, "The Lord has found a man after his own heart." That doesn't mean that David was perfect: We see evidence of his sinful nature in the biblical record. So how was he "a man after the Lord's heart"? Four events in David's life demonstrate this characteristic, and also uncover the connection to his great descendant and our Savior, Jesus Christ.
