### SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY HOUR PLANS

Vicar Samuel Helwig is teaching the final session of his four-part series, "David: A Man after the Lord's Heart," this weekend. Pastor Strey will lead a study of the two one-chapter letters written by St. John on May 14 (2 John) and May 21 (3 John). These two short letters speak to the importance of church fellowship—supporting those who teach the truth and standing up against false teaching. As usual, these classes begin at 9:25 a.m. After the single 9:00 a.m. service on May 28, an informal history presentation will be given about the building expansion project from ten years ago. On Sunday, June 4, Pastor Eric Roecker, director of the WELS Commission on Evangelism, will offer a presentation on personal outreach at 9:25 a.m. This presentation connects to the "Let's Go!" series of evangelism classes offered at Crown of Life last year. Our next voters' meeting will be held between services during the Bible study hour on June 11. Worship will be slightly abbreviated to ensure a 9:00 a.m. start time for the meeting. Children's Sunday School continues through May 21. Sunday School classes for children are postponed during the summer months, and will resume the Sunday after Labor Day.
