SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY HOUR PLANS

Pastor Strey is leading a study of the two one chapter letters written by St. John on May 14 (2 John) and May 21 (3 John). These two short letters speak to the importance of church fellowship—supporting those who teach the truth and standing up against false teaching. As usual, these classes begin at 9:25 a.m. After the single 9:00 a.m. service on May 28, an informal history presentation will be given about the building expansion project from ten years ago. On Sunday, June 4, Pastor Eric Roecker, director of the WELS Commission on Evangelism, will offer a presentation on personal outreach at 9:25 a.m. This presentation connects to the “Let’s Go!” series of evangelism classes offered at Crown of Life last year. Crown of Life's building expansion—our church sanctuary and school classroom wing—were completed ten years ago in May. We will mark this anniversary on Sunday, May 28 with a special single service at 9:00 a.m. May 28 is also Pentecost Day, the "anniversary" of the Holy Christian Church (Acts 2:1-41). Pastor Michael Helwig, who served Crown of Life from 2003 to 2018, will be our guest preacher. A presentation about the building project will follow the service. AUGSBURG CONFESSION ANNIVERSARY

On June 25, 1530, our Lutheran forefathers publicly presented the Augsburg Confession, the first official Lutheran statement of faith, which confessed what the Lutheran Church believes and also addressed errors that had crept into the 16th century Roman Catholic Church. We often celebrate this event when it is a significant anniversary milestone year, or when June 25 is a Sunday. Since June 25 occurs on a Sunday this year, we will mark this anniversary in our regular Thursday and Sunday services on June 22 and 25. Our guest preacher will be Dr. Mark Braun, professor emeritus of theology at Wisconsin Lutheran College, who also taught a Bible class at Crown of Life earlier this year. Please plan to join us for this service remembering this important event from our Lutheran history and heritage.
