### AUGSBURG CONFESSION ANNIVERSARY: SPECIAL SERVICES AND PRESENTATION

On June 25, 1530, our Lutheran forefathers publicly presented the Augsburg Confession, the first official Lutheran statement of faith, which confessed what the Lutheran Church believes and addressed errors that had crept into the 16th century Roman Catholic Church. We typically celebrate this event when it is a significant anniversary milestone year, or when June 25 is a Sunday. Since June 25 occurs on a Sunday this year, we will mark this anniversary in our regular Thursday and Sunday services on June 22 and 25. Our guest preacher will be Dr. Mark Braun, professor emeritus of theology at Wisconsin Lutheran College, who also taught a Bible class at Crown of Life earlier this year. During the Bible study hour between the morning services on June 25 (9:25 to 10:15 a.m.), Prof. Braun will offer a presentation on the history and content of the Augsburg Confession. This brief presentation will be followed by a question-and-answer session featuring a panel of pastors. For this panel, Prof. Braun will be joined by Professor Jonathan Micheel from Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary, who teaches the Augsburg Confession Class at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary, and Pastor Strey. Join us for this service and presentation remembering this significant event from our Lutheran history and heritage.
