SUMMER WORSHIP SERIES

How do you define *Christian*? What does a Christian look like? Ask those questions to ten different people and you will likely get ten different answers!

This summer we are offering a series of sermons and services that define the term Christian and describe what Christians do. We will be struck by how often we do not do all those things. There likely are times when people could look at our behavior and assume we were unbelievers. Yet throughout this series Jesus will demonstrate that ultimately a Christian is one who runs to Christ for forgiveness precisely because he has failed to live like what he is—a Christian. As we receive the mercy of Christ, it moves us to strive with all our being to better fit Christ's beautiful definition, doing all the things Jesus says that Christians do.

Our summer service and sermon series will use the following themes from now through August 13. Dates are listed for Sundays. Thursday services use the same sermon and service themes as the Sunday that follows.
