SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY HOUR RESUMES JANUARY 7

The Sunday Bible study hour for all ages resumes this weekend between services from 9:25 to 10:15 a.m. Children's Sunday School begins with an opening devotion in the church, and then continues with individual age-appropriate classes in the school classrooms. The adult/teen Bible class meets during the same time in the Timothy Room (fellowship hall).

The adult/teen class is beginning a new series called "What Do You Want in Your Church?" The last book of the Bible, Revelation, begins with seven letters addressed to real churches in the late first century. Jesus' words of commendation and condemnation to those churches contain the same messages that today's churches need to hear and heed. Pastor Johnold Strey will lead us in a study of one letter each week beginning this Sunday.

EPIPHANY SEASON MISSION FESTIVAL

Crown of Life will host a Mission Festival Sunday on January 21. We will welcome seminary student C.J. Fury, who represents the WELS Vicar in Mission Settings program. Mr. Fury is a senior at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in Mequon (and a classmate of our senior vicar, Zack Zuberbier). During this school year, he is serving as the seminary's student recruiter. Last year he served as a vicar in a home mission congregation in the Denver area. He will explain the Vicar in Missions Settings program and how it helps future pastors develop skills and gain confidence in home mission work (i.e. establishing new congregations in the United States). Mr. Fury will preach for our services on January 18 and 21 and will offer a presentation between the services on January 21 during the Bible study hour. A freewill door offering will be gathered after all three services to support the work of WELS Home Missions.
