EPIPHANY SEASON MISSION FESTIVAL

This weekend is Crown of Life's Epiphany season mission festival. We welcome seminary student C.J. Fury, who represents the WELS Vicar in Mission Settings program, as our guest preacher and presenter. Mr. Fury is a senior at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in Mequon (and a classmate of our senior vicar, Zack Zuberbier). During this school year, he is serving as the seminary's student recruiter. Last year he served as a vicar in a home mission congregation in the Denver area. He is preaching for all our services this weekend, and during the Sunday Bible study hour, he will offer a presentation that explains the Vicar in Missions Settings program and how it helps future pastors develop skills and gain confidence in home mission work (i.e. establishing new congregations in the United States). A freewill door offering will be gathered after all three services to support the work of WELS Home Missions.

PASTOR CALL MEETING

Crown of Life will hold a special voters meeting after the 10:30 a.m. service on Sunday, February 4, starting at noon. The meeting will be for the purpose of extending a divine call for a second pastor to serve our congregation. Pastor Daniel Leyrer, who serves as the District President of the Southeastern Wisconsin District of the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS), will be present for this first call meeting. MIDWEEK WORSHIP FOR LENT

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is February 14 this year. During Lent, we will hold a series of six midweek services on Wednesdays from February 14 to March 20 at 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. (Our usual Thursday evening services at 6:30 p.m. are postponed during Lent, but resume after Easter Sunday.) A dinner will be served each week between the two services in the Timothy Room (fellowship hall). Please join us on Wednesdays during Lent as we begin our annual journey to the Savior's cross.

BIBLE STUDIES AT CROWN OF LIFE

Crown of Life's current Sunday morning Bible class is called, "What Do You Want in Your Church?" The last book of the Bible, Revelation, begins with seven letters addressed to real churches in the late first century. Jesus' words of commendation and condemnation to those churches contain the same messages that today's churches need to hear and heed. Pastor Johnold Strey will lead us in a study of one letter each week on Sundays between services from 9:25 to 10:15 a.m. in the Timothy Room (fellowship hall) from now through February 25. (There is no class this week due to the Mission Festival presentation between services.)

Our Tuesday "Early Risers" class is studying the Gospel of Luke. Join Pastor Paul Seiltz as he leads this study in the Fireside Room on Tuesdays at 6:00 a.m.

Our Wednesday midweek class is finishing up a study of the book of Acts. A new Bible book will be chosen for the study after the study of Acts concludes. Pastor Strey leads this study in the Timothy Room (fellowship hall) on Wednesdays at 10:00 a.m.

Our current Bible Basics class is about to finish, and Pastor Strey will be looking to start a new class soon. This is the class that reviews the basic teachings of the Bible as taught in the Lutheran Church, which prepares people for membership and participation in the Lord's Supper at Crown of Life. It's also a great class to take as a review of basic biblical teaching.
