### REFORMATION SUNDAY

Our annual celebration of the Lutheran Reformation will be held on Sunday, October 30. We will follow a special schedule that morning, with a single service at 9:00 a.m. and the Bible study hour to follow at 10:30 a.m. Our service on October 30 will be modern adaptation of Luther's *German Mass*, the order of worship that Luther prepared for the German-speaking congregations of his era. Prof. Jonathan Micheel from Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary will be our guest preacher.

### SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY

Our current Sunday Bible study on the book of Hebrews concludes this weekend. We thank David Bartelt, our guest presenter for this class, for teaching us this six-week survey course.

For Reformation Sunday, October 30, we will have a one-session Bible study class on Christian Freedom, an important concept related to the Lutheran Reformation. This lesson was left over from a past class that was offered just as COVID lockdowns required us to cancel public worship and Bible study for a time in 2020. Our study of Christian Freedom will show us why it is so important to refrain from making "rules" where God has not, but also how we exercise our freedom as Christians with wisdom and discernment. Next week's class will meet at 10:30 a.m. in the Timothy Room after the single 9am Reformation festival service.

In November and December, we will embark on a study called Heaven and Hell: Eternal Life, Eternal Punishment. As we enter a time in the Church Year when we discuss issues such as death, the final judgment, and eternal life, our Sunday Bible study will delve deeper into these topics, clarifying the Bible's message and bringing us comfort as we think about the life that awaits God's people after this life. We hope you'll join us for this study led by Pastor Strey in the Timothy Room on Sundays beginning at 9:25 a.m.
