In Catechism, we will be discussing the 3rd and 4th Commandments. We are just over halfway with our novel, and the students seem to really enjoy "Number the Stars". ## Seventh-Eighth Grade News

The upper grades are working together on our presentations for Entertainment Night which will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2023. We are excited to present four skits. All of the skits are based on miracles during Jesus' ministry. A miracle is something that can't be explained by how we know our world works. But Jesus could do miracles because he is God and anything is possible for God.

"Water Into Wine" is the first skit presented by half of the seventh and eighth-grade students. Jesus turned six large jars of water into wine at a wedding in Cana. As a result of this, His first miracle, Jesus' disciples believed in Him.

Our second skit, presented by the fifth and sixth graders, will show how Jesus healed a man who had been lame for 38 years, and no one seemed to be excited by it. It is called, "The Miracle No One Noticed."

The other half of the seventh and eighth graders will present "Wonder Bread" when Jesus miraculously fed more than 5,000 with five loaves of bread and two fish.

And our final skit performed by all four grades is called "Yo! Now I See!" and shows how Jesus healed a man who had been born blind. The Pharisees refused to believe in Jesus even when the evidence was overwhelming. They rejected him because they were spiritually blind, but they thought they weren't. In this story, once again Jesus heals on the Sabbath day, enraging the legalistic Pharisees. In the aftermath of the healing, the man who was born blind gives a compelling testimony to them and becomes a follower of Christ.

We're enjoying practicing our skits with a delightful and creative twist to the four Bible stories we are working on. We hope everyone can make it, but please let us know if your child will not be able to be here on the first Friday in March for "Entertainment Night."
