September 11, 2001, is a date that will be forever remembered because of the bombings of the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and the crash of Flight 93. The people of our nation were stunned and enraged by the tragedy, then determined to punish those responsible.

In all, approximately 3,000 people lost their lives. Most were

Americans, but people from about 60 other countries also perished. In memory of those who died and the heroes

who tried to save them, President George W. Bush designated September 11 as Patriot Day. The observance was signed into public record on December 18, 2001.

Flags at public buildings and businesses fly at half-staff on that day, and people are urged to observe a moment of silence. On September 11, we also remember the survivors of the attacks and those who lost family members, friends, and co-workers.

At Crown of Life please take the time to observe the flag that is flown for the month of September. The flag is different from the normal Stars and Stripes. This special flag has the names of every victim lost in the 9/11 tragedy.



The faith of many was tested and strengthened. Remember what the Lord has given us and how quickly it can be lost or how often it goes unappreciated. To God be the Glory.

## Third-Fourth Grade News

After two weeks, the students are starting to settle into the routines of the classroom. Setting up a Bible passage and copying the assignment book by the 8:25am **start of classes** is a challenge. Transitions between classes is another one. Every day it is getting better!

Classes this week include studying the Bible lessons of The Flood and the Tower of Babel. Memory treasures are Hymn 593:1 and Isaiah 43:11. Reading is continuing the story started last week and grammar is finishing up chapter 1 on punctuation and capitalization.

Make sure you are checking PowerSchool for your child's progress. However, be reminded that at the beginning of the quarter there are not many grades to

give a clear average. Please be patient in these early days.

Finally, the first book orders came home this week. There are more books available online. Please go through the forms carefully. Some books are not always God-pleasing while many others are. The classroom code is GLJD4. There is a note attached to the order forms.
