CC Getting Started

Cross Country practices start Tuesday, August 23, from 3:30 – 5:00 and will take place Tuesday - Friday. Meets will take place on Wednesdays starting September 7 at Willowood Park (Pilgrim hosts). There is still time to get on board and run cross country this year. Teams are divided by gender and usually by grade (6th & under division and 7th /8th division). The number of athletes needed per team varies with the race but ranges between 3 and 7. Incomplete teams or additional runners run and score as individuals so there is no bench sitting in cross country except for injury. Season length is 4-8 weeks depending on the ability/interest of the athlete. Distance of race is 1.5 or 2 miles depending on the meet. Most meets are on Wednesdays until the championship portion of the season. Athletes should attend as many practices as they can but are not required to attend them all. Contact Mrs. Matter if you have an interest in joining.
