If you suspect your child might have COVID and you choose to get them tested, you can choose to send them to school until results are received or you could have them stay at home until results are received. If the results are positive then the child would need to stay home from school for 5 days **not** including the testing day. After 5 days they can return to school if all symptoms are gone. They do not need to wear a mask unless you choose to have your child wear a mask.

Virtual School - Virtual school will **only** be offered to students that have tested positive for COVID or are waiting for results. Our goal is to get assignments together by noon every day. We also can send a chromebook home for virtual schooling if needed.
